Organization (ICDPASO)

Mediation Entity Fee Schedule

This fee schedule is formulated in accordance with the the Article 16 of the International Commercial Dispute Prevention and Settlement Organization Commercial (ICDPASO) Mediation Rules and other relevant provisions, and taking into account the operation of ICDPASO Mediation Entity (hereinafter referred to as the "IME").

The mediation fee includes the case registration fee, administrative fee, mediator's fee, and other costs confirmed by the parties, which shall be shared equally by the parties in principle.

The parties shall prepay the mediation fee no later than 3 working days after the mediator has been selected or appointed. The mediation will be initiated after the mediation fee has been prepaid. Upon termination of the mediation, IME shall fix the total costs of the mediation and reimburse the parties for any excess payment.

I. Case Registration Fee

The party or parties filing a request for mediation shall pay a case registration fee of RMB 1,000, which will cover the expenses for examining the application for mediation, contacting the parties, registration of case, and managing the archives. The case registration fee

is non-refundable under any circumstances, and shall be credited into the prepayment of the party or parties filing the request.

II. Administrative Fee

The administrative fee shall be fixed at the IME's discretion depending on the tasks carried out by the IME in arrangements for venue, staff assistance, facilities, etc., and shall normally not exceed the following:

From 100,000,001 to 300,000,000	Not Exceeding 70,000
From 300,000,001 to 500,000,000	Not Exceeding 95,000
Over 500,000,000	Not Exceeding 110,000

Where the amount in dispute is uncertain, the administrative fee and prepayment shall be fixed by the IME at its discretion, taking into account the circumstance and the complexity of the dispute.

III. Mediator's Fee

If agreed by the parties and the mediator, the IME may determine the

mediator's fee based on the disputed amount, the complexity of the case, the projected number of days of mediation, number of parties involved, the mode of mediation, the number of attendees, and value of the subject matter. The mediator's fee may also be calculated based on an hourly rate fixed by the IME after consulting with the mediator and the parties, based on the time reasonably spent by the mediator in the proceedings. When a mediator charges an hourly rate, the hourly rate standard, the content of the mediation service, and the way and the time of issuing the hourly rate list shall be clarified.

Where the amount in dispute is uncertain, it shall be jointly determined by the IME and mediator.

Where the parties and the mediator have agreed upon a method and rate for determining the mediator's fee, their agreement shall prevail, subject to the approval of the IME.

IV. Fee Reduction of Mediation and Arbitration Mechanisms

For cases where the parties have reached a settlement agreement through mediation by IME, the party or parties may, based on the relevant provisions of the ICDPASO Commercial Arbitration Rules and the arbitration clause, request ICDPASO Arbitration Court (hereinafter referred to as the "Arbitration Court") to render an arbitral award in accordance with the terms of the settlement agreement.

The arbitration fee payable by the parties may be reduced on the following conditions:

1. For cases where the amount in dispute is definite, the arbitration fee actually payable will be proportionately discounted at a rate of 30% to 60% on the original arbitration fee calculated.

2. For cases where the amount in dispute is uncertain, the Arbitration Court shall determine the amount of the actual arbitration fee after taking into consideration of factors such as the complexity of the case, with reference to the proportion stated in item 1.

Note: Under special situations, the parties may request a reduction of the mediation fee. The case registration fee will be charged in full but other mediation fees may be reduced subject to the approval of the Secretary-General of ICDPASO.
